“This office once again concludes that provisions of Article III, Section 9 of the Charter for the City of Douglas citing: “if requested, the Council shall grant a public hearing within thirty days following notice of removal” do not apply and no hearing is warranted for the fundamental reason that the Council’s decision of January 17, 2019, was not a removal action, but merely a decision on non-renewal of contract. This disposition has been informally validated by the Arizona League of Cities and is to be reviewed by the Arizona Attorney General’s office.”
