*****Press Release Update*****

The Douglas Police Department Investigations Division initiated an investigation into José Ramón Grijalva (43), a City of Douglas Public Works employee; which resulted in the execution of a search warrant at his place of residence at the 1500 block of Cochise Drive. The warrant was executed in the early morning hours of November 7, 2018: resulting in the discovery of cocaine, a narcotic substance, and additional paraphernalia associated with street level sales of the said narcotic.

Mr. Grijalva was arrested and booked into the Cochise County Jail for:

- Possession of Narcotic Drugs
- Possession of Narcotic Drugs for Sale
- Transportation for Sale of a Narcotic Drug
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Update:

Jose Ramon Grijalva appeared before the Cochise County Superior Court for sentencing on July 15, 2019 as a result of a narcotics investigation conducted by the Douglas Police Department’s Investigation Division in November of 2018. During trial Mr. Grijalva pled to Count One: sold cocaine, a narcotic drug; a class 2 felony and Count Two: attempted to knowingly possess a narcotic drug for sale, cocaine; a class 3 felony.

Mr. Grijalva was sentenced to three (3) years in the Department of Corrections with credit for two days and a \$2,000.00 fine + 83% surcharge for Count One. As for Count Two, Mr. Grijalva was sentenced to 5 years probation to commence upon his release from the Department of Corrections along with a \$500.00 fine + 83% surcharge.

Mr. Grijalva was immediately taken into custody after the sentencing as is normal procedure.
