

ORDINANCE NO. 19-1109

2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF
3 THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA,
4 AMENDING ORDINANCES 718, 837 AND 10-987, AND
5 ADJUSTING FEES FOR PARKS & RECREATION
6 CENTER FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS IN ORDER TO
7 RECOVER OPERATING COSTS, ESTABLISHING
8 SEVERABILITY OF COMPONENTS OF ORDINANCE;
9 AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

7 **WHEREAS**, the Parks and Recreation Center continue to operate for the benefit and enjoyment
8 of the residents of the City of Douglas and the surrounding area; and

9 **WHEREAS**, adjusting fees for Parks & Recreation Center facilities and programs along with
10 streamlining the application process is necessary and appropriate for the orderly management of
11 programs and fee adjustments are necessary to recover the cost of operation and maintenance of
12 the facilities; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 5(3) of the City Charter requires that fee rates for City
12 services be set by Ordinance; and

13 **WHEREAS**, this Ordinance amends Ordinances 718, 837 and 10-987 and repeals all
14 ordinances and provisions in conflict herewith.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglas,
16 Arizona, as follows:

16 **Section 1. As to Chapter 12.28.40** adding fee for liquor permits at are parks - \$10 per permit
17 (also adding language that alcohol permits may not only be authorized by City Manager but also
18 a "designee", as noted on the attached DMC Chapter 12 with modifications per Exhibit A;

19 **Section 2. As to Chapter 12.40** as noted on the attached DMC Chapter 12 with modifications
20 per Exhibit A:

- 20 • Add \$50.00 permit fee to special events requested with 14 days or less prior to the
21 proposed event date without guarantee that the event will be approved.
- 21 • Revise Recreation Programs from \$5.00-\$25.00 to \$5.00-\$60.00
- 22 • Eliminate family rates for City recreation programs of \$40.00 per family and replace
23 with an up to 50% discount per additional family member
- 23 • Revise City Recreation Youth Sports from \$20.00-\$25.00 to \$20.00-\$60.00
- 24 • Eliminate family rates for City recreation youth sports of \$40.00 per family and replace
25 with an up to 50% discount per additional family member
- Revise City adult sports leagues from \$20.00-\$30.00 per person to \$50.00-\$70.00 per
person and eliminate \$100 team rate
- Revise use of recreation rooms by agencies/business from \$20/hr. to \$35/hr.
- Revise use of recreation rooms by agencies/business (nonprofits) from \$10/hr. to \$20/hr.

- Revise vendor booth spaces on city events on city property from \$50.00 per event to \$50.00 per day and add \$10.00 per day for informational booths
- Revise ramada use fees from \$5 to \$15
- Add the following new fees:
- Portable Stage use - \$100 per event (includes nonprofits), \$70 staff setup and \$35 staff setup for non-profits
- Bleachers - \$75 per event (includes nonprofits), \$25 staff setup
- Portable Lights - \$50 per day, \$25 per day for non-profits
- Add \$20.00 per day for electric hookup at City parks or \$100.00 per month
- Revise special event permit from \$30 to \$45

Section 3. As to Chapter 12.50 as noted on the attached DMC Chapter 12 with modifications per Exhibit A:

- Revise parade/public assembly from \$30 to \$40 with other Department Directors as designees authorized to issue parade permits besides the City Manager.

Section 4. As to Chapter 12.70 as noted on the attached DMC Chapter 12 with modifications per Exhibit A:

- Revise Visitor Center fees per room that now includes a cleaning fee under various options of attendants and food and beverage options as listed in Chapter 12.70.
- Under 50 people no food from \$60 to \$70 and with food from \$80 to \$110
- Add nonprofit no food fee for \$50 and \$70 with food
- 50-100 people no food from \$90 to \$110 and with food from \$110 to \$130
- Add nonprofit no food fee for \$60 and \$80 with food
- Over 100 people no food from \$100 to \$130 and with food from \$120 to \$150
- Add nonprofit no food fee for \$70 and \$90 with food
- Use of kitchen facility (additional) from \$100 to \$120
- Eliminated exemption on City sponsored events and offered a 50% discount instead.

Section 5. As to Chapter 12.80 as noted on the attached DMC Chapter 12 with modifications per Exhibit A:


- Revise Swim fees discount passes for adults from \$40 to \$50 and if purchasing 3 or more passes from \$33 to \$35
- Revise Swim fees discount passes for Senior citizens if purchasing 3 or more passes from \$18 to \$20
- Included fees for private parties although being charged, and added to new chapter 12.80.030. Increased costs of lifeguards from \$10 per hour to \$15 (to include actual pay and benefits) Also added language that lifeguard coverage for parties shall be determined by staff in accordance to safety standards and that fees may be administratively set according to the activity and costs to provide service.

Section 6. As to Chapter 12.90 as noted on the attached DMC Chapter 12 with modifications per Exhibit A:

- Revise Aquatic Center Racquetball punch pass for seniors from \$25 to \$30



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
