

On August 15, 2021 at about 2:00 P.M., officers of the Douglas Police Department were dispatched to a call of an unresponsive male at the 1300 block of 4th street. When officers arrived, they found a male subject who showed signs of trauma. A security sweep of the premises was conducted before medical personnel were allowed into the home. Douglas Fire Department evaluated the victim and found the male to be deceased. The scene was secured for further investigation by Douglas Police Department Investigations Division.

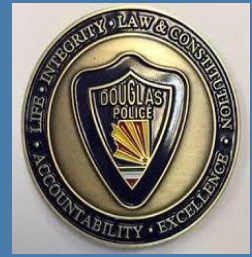
The Douglas Police Department was at the location for several hours processing the scene. The matter is being investigated as a homicide. No arrests have been made and the investigation is ongoing. Update

On October 11, 2021 at about 9:30 P.M., Detectives with the Douglas Police Department arrested Raul Peralta Navalles at the Raul H. Castro Port of Entry on a felony warrant for 1st Degree Murder as well as two warrants for Failure to appear on traffic violations out of the Douglas Police Department. Navalles had been identified as the alleged sole suspect in the hours following the discovery of the homicide. Detectives worked closely with Mexican authorities after learning that Navalles had reportedly fled into Agua Prieta, Sonora. Navalles was detained and turned over by Mexican authorities, based on the homicide warrant. Navalles was booked into the Cochise County Jail.

The Douglas Police Department attributes the successful outcome of the investigation to the persistence of our Detectives, the collaboration from the surrounding agencies and the Mexican authorities.
