

Halloween Safety Tips



- ♦ Children under the age of 12 should always trick-o-treat with adult supervision or in groups.
- ♦ Stick to familiar areas that are well lit.
- ♦ Add reflective tape, stickers, glow in the dark bracelets to your costume or carry a flashlight!
- ♦ Remember to cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks.
- ♦ Always walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks, you can walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible.
- ♦ Trick-o-treat at the door step and avoid entering a stranger's home.
- ♦ Have a trusted adult check your candy before you eat it.

- If there is an emergency contact 911.
- If you want to report suspicious activity contact the non-emergency number at (520) 417-7550
- If an officer is nearby and you need his/her attention, remember the difference between a friendly wave and a signal for help.
