April concluded with Part I Crime holding steady; up 8% over last year. Driving the increase is an increase in reported thefts and aggravated assault.

There were 3985 calls for service during the month of April; a 14% decrease over last year; with 796 attributed to traffic stops. Arrests are now down 14.6% compared to 2018.

Reported accidents are relatively flat in all categories while enforcement efforts are down 35% compared to 2018.
