Do I qualify for a bus card?

Over 60 years of age:

- Must bring a utility bill providing proof of residency
- Must provide a photo ID.

Under 60 years of age:

- Must be disabled.
- Must bring a current award letter from the Social security office.
- Must bring a utility bill providing proof of residency.
- Must provide a photo ID.

Can I ride the bus if I don't qualify for a card?

Yes. Current fares are as follows:

Adults \$1.00 Students 75¢

Seniors/Disabled .50¢

We also offer a route that goes to Cochise College/Bisbee (**Monday-Thursday**) and a DAR (Dial-A-Ride) service. Elfrida/Mc Neal route is available every other Friday; please call office for further details. **DAR service is for those who cannot walk to a bus stop. Appointments are on a first come first serve basis. Fees/Donations will be explained to you in the office.**
