



NOTICE OF POSSIBLE CITY OF DOUGLAS PERMITS AND INSPECTION FEES INCREASES

The City of Douglas is proposing changes to Title 15 of the City of Douglas Municipal Code. The proposed changes revise fees for building inspection and permitting. New fees are also being proposed for new inspections such as certificate of occupancy, mechanical, commercial plumbing, commercial electrical, solar, re-roofing, paving and demolition. Additionally, new fees for right of way permitting that includes, trenching, non-construction right of way, driveways, subdivision phase inspection, private road access, powerpoles, removal of illegal signs, street address certification, work begun without a permit and charges for maps. The proposed changes will tentatively be brought forward at the July 10, August 14 and September 11, 2019 City Council Meetings. If approved, these changes will go into effect **October 11, 2019**. The proposed increase in user fees will affect people and companies seeking permits and inspections on buildings and infrastructure in the City.

There will be an opportunity for public comments regarding the proposed changes to Title 15 of the City of Douglas Municipal Code at the Call To the Public during the July 10, August 14 and September 11, 2019 City Council Meetings at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall 425 10th Street.
