

PRESS RELEASE: Pavement Project at Castro Port of Entry to begin Jan. 6

DOUGLAS, (AZ) Dec. 26, 2019 – U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has advised the public of ongoing construction that may affect those traveling through the Raul Hector Castro Port of Entry.

Earlier this month the replacement of seven primary inspection booths and two commercial truck booths began, along with other extensive modifications. A pavement project is set to begin on Jan. 6, 2020 along First Street and Pan American Avenue. Estimated construction time is currently eight weeks, with road work to take place Monday through Thursday from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. One west-bound lane will remain open for business access. The entire roadway will reopen at the end of each day. CBP reassures travelers will not need to change their normal routine for crossing the border in Douglas during this pavement project.
