December concluded the year with Part I Crime up 5% compared to last year.

Theft and Burglary are the only two categories reflecting an increase.

Property crimes generally have the greatest occurrence and influence on the overall rate year-to-year.

There were 2072 calls for service during the month of December; reflecting a nearly 19% decrease; with 384 attributed to traffic stops. Arrests ended down 17% compared to 2018.

Reported accidents ended down 6% while enforcement efforts were down 30% compared to 2018.
