**Chapter 8.16**

- No trash rack (all customers are to provide a trash rack for waste receptacles)
- No waste receptacle (waste receptacle for your garbage must be provided)
- Over receptacle limit, (you are allowed a maximum of 6 receptacles or bags at one time)
- Receptacles are in need of immediate repair
- Lids or covers of waste receptacles need to be repaired
- Over weight limit (total weight of receptacles cannot exceed 65 pounds), limit of (6) 32 gallon bags at one time
- Container size must be 32 gallon or smaller
- Items must be bagged

**Chapter 8.32**

- Maintain the adjacent street right-of-way from property line to the curb or edge of pavement and center line of alley free of litter & weeds etc.
- Not allow any part of property visible from street, adjoining premises to detract from appearance of the immediate neighborhood, or threaten the safety & welfare
- Shall not park, store, leave, or permit the parking, storing or leaving any junk motor vehicle for a period in excess of five days upon any private property within the City
- Shall not allow any private property to become unsanitary, a fire menace, or danger to health and safety through the accumulation, growth, storage, or retention of garbage, refuse, rubbish, weeds, or accumulation of filth or debris

**SPECIAL ITEMS PICKUP**

- Trimmings need to be cut into no more than 4 feet lengths and tied into bundles not larger than 18 inches in diameter.
- The receptacles shall be protected at all times against overturning by dogs or other animals
- Boxes, cartons, and crates over 28 inches, on any one side, shall be collapsed
- Disposal of the following types of refuse is prohibited: auto bodies, septic tanks, hazardous waste, toxic chemicals, insecticides, pathological or biological waste, dead animal carcasses, radioactive material, explosives, and flammable material, *No Needles, Medicines*
- Property owner is responsible for disposal of large bulk items such as mattresses, appliances, furniture, tree trunks, tires, etc.
