I would like to share a few updates that may be helpful if you are conducting business with the City while this situation continues to unfold.


First, we have put in place guidance for all our employees detailing how to protect against transmission of the virus, including hand-washing protocols and enhanced cleaning of high-touch areas in our local offices. We will continue monitoring coronavirus (COVID-19) updates and will respond accordingly based on the advice of public health authorities.

Second, I want to remind our customers of the various methods we have in place to interact with us online and over the phone. All customers have access to their water billing accounts through the customer portal on the City of Douglas website, municipalonlinepayments.com/douglasaz, where they can review and manage their account and make online payments. All customers also have the option to make utility payments by mail or through the phone by calling (520) 417-7334, Monday-Friday 8am – 5pm. If you are to mail in your utility payments, please take steps to ensure that the payment is received on or before the 23rd of March. Additionally, you may also drop off your payment at the designated drive through drop box on the corner of 9th St and H Ave (South West corner of City Hall). If you have further questions about your water bill, you can reach our Customer Service team at (520) 417-7334, they are always happy to provide assistance.
