City of Douglas Proclaims Nov 1 as Extra Mile Day

DOUGLAS, ARIZ. (October 29, 2021) - At Wednesday's Special Council Meeting, Mayor Donald C. Huish issued a proclamation declaring November 1, 2021 as "Extra Mile Day".

Extra Mile Day is a national movement that recognizes those who are strengthening their communities and making them a better place to live. Douglas joins an estimated 500 communities nationwide who will be recognizing Extra Mile Day.

During the special meeting, Mayor Huish presented certificates to Extra Mile Honorees Doris Ford-Webb and Desiree Rice. Linda Gomez and Ken Nelson were also honored but not available at the meeting. Mrs. Gomez and Mr. Nelson will be honored at a later time.

Doris Ford-Webb, a Douglas native, was honored for her volunteerism in Christmas events, and extensive volunteer work with the Food Bank among other projects. Desiree Rice moved to Douglas in 2020 and was recognized for her city-wide cleanup efforts and for sponsoring families for food and gifts during the holidays.

"I urge each individual in the community to take time on this day to not only go the extra mile in his or her own life, but to also acknowledge all those who are inspirational in their efforts and commitment to make their organization, families, community, country, or world a better place" stated Huish.
